What was the issue to be addressed?	Increase PCN clinical capacity to review the backlog of Cardio, Renal and Metabolic (CVRM) patients caused by COVID-19. The new clinics will be in-addition to the existing clinics normally provided by the GP Practices within the PCN and won't seek to replace existing clinics made available to patients. Reduction in long waiting times to be seen by a 'specialist' Drive improvement of understanding within primary care to effectively manage CVRM patients. Education support for multiple stakeholders within primary care.
What were the results?	The output from this project was 507 patients were triaged for review and 329 patients were seen in consultation clinics over 30 weeks.
