<b>Project title</b>	Cardio Renal Clinic Joint Working Project
<b>Duration</b>	September 2022 to April 2023
<b>Project partners</b>	Cross Counties Primary Care Network and AstraZeneca UK Limited
<b>What was the issue to be addressed?</b>	Increase PCN clinical capacity to review the backlog of Cardio, Renal and Metabolic (CVRM) patients caused by COVID-19. The new clinics will be in-addition to the existing clinics normally provided by the GP Practices within the PCN and won't seek to replace existing clinics made available to patients. Reduction in long waiting times to be seen by a 'specialist' Drive improvement of understanding within primary care to effectively manage CVRM patients. Education support for multiple stakeholders within primary care.
<b>What were the results?</b>	The output from this project was 428 patients were triaged for review and 354 patients were seen in consultation clinics over 29 weeks.
