

A DECLARATION OF JOINT WORKING BETWEEN

University Hospitals Birmingham NHS Foundation Trust and AstraZeneca UK LTD

The University Hospitals Birmingham NHS Foundation Trust and AstraZeneca UK LTD are engaged in a Joint Working project called 'Birmingham Lung Cancer Prehabilitation Project'.

The overall aim of this Joint Working Agreement is to formalise and establish an Out-patient lung cancer habilitation radiotherapy clinic for patients with the potential for/or who are receiving radical radiotherapy. Enabling support for combined modality long course treatments and aiming to increase the number of patients being optimised for curative intent and improve lung cancer survival across Birmingham.

The objectives of this project are:

- Optimise physical fitness, emotional wellbeing & manage side effects to improve clinical & patient reported outcomes.
- Improve accessibility to treatments by reducing inequalities and variations in health along the patient pathway.
- Promote cost effective professional development, positive communication & joined up working across patient and professional boundaries.

This project will run from 1st Nov 2022 to 31st October2023 and both parties have contributed resources for this initiative.

With the agreement of both parties the project start date was amended for the project to run from the 1st April 2023 and ending on 30 March 2024 a term of 1 year
