Project title	Cardio Renal Clinic Joint Working Project
Duration	March 2024 to September 2025
Project partners	Caritas Primary Care Network and AstraZeneca UK Limited
What was the issue to be addressed?	Increase PCN clinical capacity to review the backlog of Cardio, Renal and Metabolic (CVRM) patients caused by COVID-19. The new clinics will be in-addition to the existing clinics normally provided by the GP Practices within the PCN and won't seek to replace existing clinics made available to patients. Reduction in long waiting times to be seen by a 'specialist' Drive improvement of understanding within primary care to effectively manage CVRM patients. Education support for multiple stakeholders within primary care.
What were the results?	The output from this project was 493 patients were triaged for review and all 300 patients were seen in consultation clinics over 24 weeks of which 57 patients were optimised onto guideline directive therapy.
