



Executive summary of Cardio Renal Metabolic Joint Working Outputs

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Project title	Cranbrook PCN Cardio Renal Clinic Joint Working Project
Duration	29 Weeks
Project partners	Cranbrook PCN and AstraZeneca UK Limited
What was the issue to be addressed?	Increase PCN clinical capacity to review the backlog of Cardio, Renal and Metabolic (CVRM) patients caused by COVID-19. The new clinics will be in addition to the existing clinics normally provided by the GP Practices within the PCN, and won't seek to replace existing clinics made available to patients. Reduce long waiting times to be seen by a 'specialist'. Drive improvement of understanding within primary care to effectively manage CVRM patients. Support education for multiple stakeholders within primary care.
What were the results?	The output from this project was 1362 patients were triaged and seen in clinic for review over the 29 weeks of which, 709 patients were optimised onto guideline directed medical therapy, reducing wait times for patients. AstraZeneca also contributed to the upskill on CVRM patient pathway management.
