

An A-Z of NHS Lothian Diabetes Care

Executive Summary:

A collaborative working project involving AstraZeneca and NHS Lothian in the co-production of a series of 12 online diabetes educational modules suitable for a broad range of healthcare professionals involved in the care of individuals with diabetes to include staff working in ward and acute areas, community settings including district nursing teams and primary care.

The vision is the development and provision of Lothian-relevant modules in the form of short videos covering all aspects of diabetes management. This would enable staff to be upskilled and able to demonstrate on-going competence in diabetes management. These videos will also be relevant and applicable to audiences outside of Lothian, especially across Scotland and NI, and to a similar extent in Wales and England.

The modules will be hosted on both the internal NHS Lothian platform and AstraZeneca's InterACT platform to enable wider access.
