

## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY INPUT

BETWEEN

AND

South Bucks PCN

South Bucks PCN and AstraZeneca UK Ltd are engaged in a Joint Working Project called 'Cardio Renal Joint Working'.

This project will run from 2<sup>nd</sup> of October 2023 to 2<sup>nd</sup> of October 2024 and both parties have contributed resources for this initiative.

The aims of this joint working project are to:

- Increase PCN clinical capacity to review the backlog of Cardio, Renal and Metabolic (CVRM) patients caused by COVID-19. The new clinics will be in-addition to the existing clinics normally provided by the GP Practices within the PCN, and won't seek to replace existing clinics made available to patients.
- Reduce long waiting times to be seen by a 'specialist'
- Drive improvement of understanding within primary care to effectively manage CVRM patients. ● Support education for multiple stakeholders within primary care

This project was initially planned to run from 10/2023 to 10/2024 and both parties have contributed resources for this initiative. However, due to delays and continued demand to deliver the project an extension has been made to this joint working till 03/2025.

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
